A Simple Model for Coaching

FOCUS


Connect with your client, identify coachable topic, zero-in on what's wanted and what's needed

LEARNING LOOP

Create new awareness about the issue, options, and personal growth

FORWARD THE ACTION

Design next steps, negotiate obstacles, accountability, and commitment

Active Listening

Probably the most important thing a coach does.

Good questions evoke awareness from the person you're coaching.



Ask Questions

Encourage



Change and growth are difficult, so acknowledge the client's effort and progress.

Observation

Notice the client's energy, pace, tone, silence and other observable behaviors and share accordingly.



Deliver Concise Messages

Every so often you need to offer an insight, make an observation, or share some feedback.




